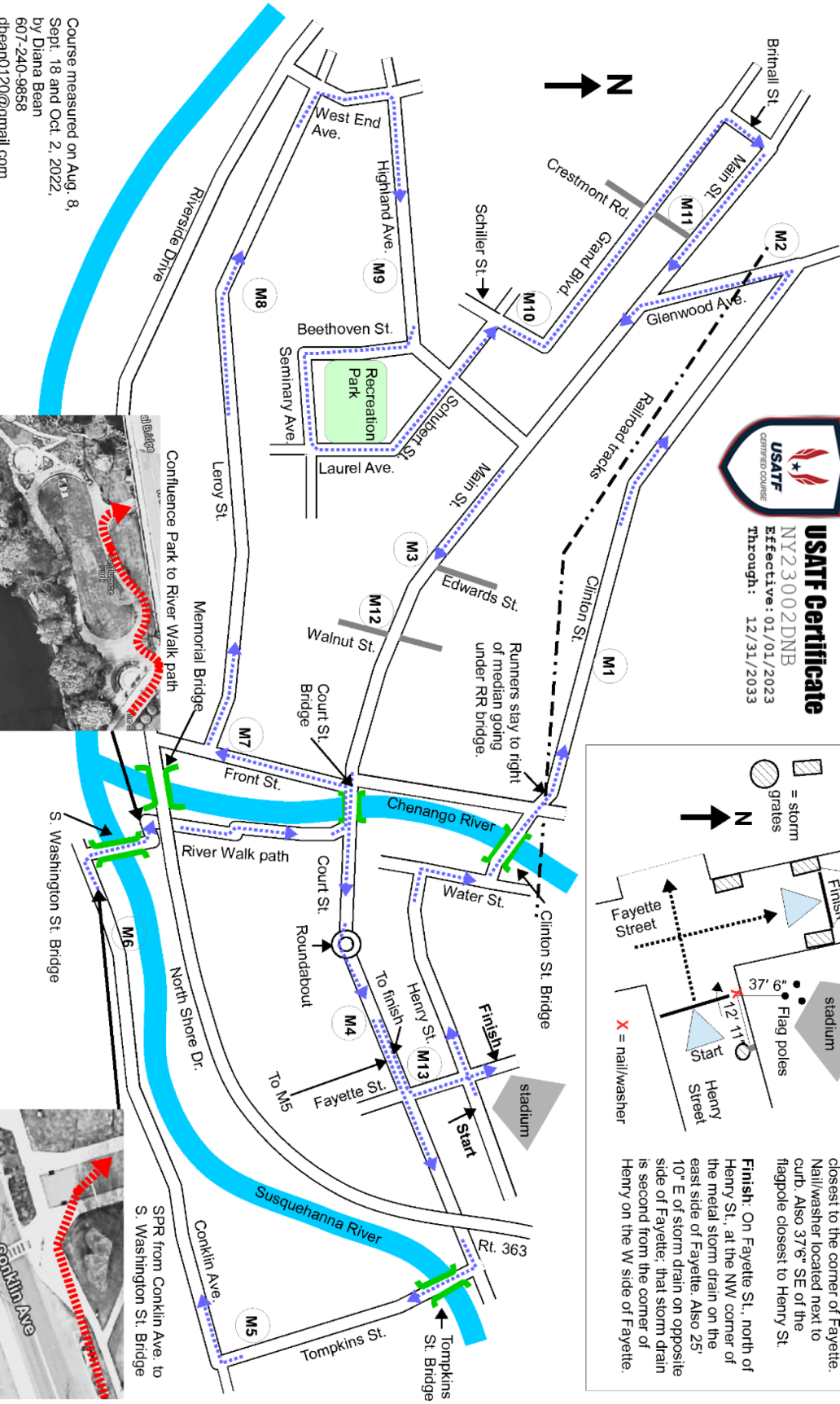
Greater Binghamton Bridge Run Half Marathon 2023

- Course was measured using the full width of the road and the shortest possible route with two exceptions: 1. On Clinton St., runners stay to right going under RR overpass. 2. On Main St., runners stay to the right of the double yellow line, running with traffic.

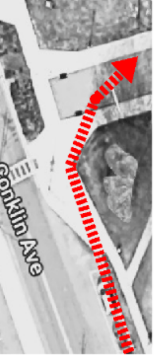


Start / Finish detail

Start: On Henry St. in right-hand turn lane in front of stadium gates. 12' 11" W of the small straight portion (next to curb) of the round storm drain closest to the corner of Fayette. Nail/washer located next to curb. Also 37'6" SE of the flagpole closest to Henry St.

Finish: On Fayette St., north of Henry St., at the NW corner of the metal storm drain on the east side of Fayette. Also 25' 10" E of storm drain on opposite side of Fayette; that storm drain is second from the corner of Henry on the W side of Fayette.

Course description and mile splits

Start: On Henry St. in the right-hand turn lane in front of Mirabito Stadium gates, 12' 11" W of the small straight portion (next to curb) of the round storm drain closest to the corner of Fayette St. PK nail/washer located next to curb. Also 37'6" SE of the flagpole closest to Henry Street.

Head W on Henry St.

Turn R on Water St.

Turn L on Clinton St. and cross Clinton Street Bridge.

Runners stay to the right (running with traffic) when going under the railroad overpass. Continue W on Clinton St.

M1: Clinton St., just E side of playground equipment for Boys and Girls Club.

Turn L on Glenwood Ave. and head S.

M2: Glenwood Ave., around the corner from Clinton, at the southern edge of the driveway to convenience store parking lot.

Turn L on Main St. and head SE, moving over to the eastbound lane and running with traffic. This is also the shortest route.

M3: Main St., on the western edge of the crosswalk across Main St. on the E side of Edwards St.

Continue E on Main St., which becomes Court St. upon crossing the Court Street Bridge. Stay to the R on the Court St. roundabout.

M4: Court St., by AVRE, at City of Binghamton City utility pole 2933 before PedX sign.

Turn R on Tompkins St. and cross Tompkins Street Bridge, heading S.

M5: Tompkins St., even with the front of the Southside Auto building, just before R turn onto Conklin Ave.

Turn R on Conklin Ave. and head W.

M6: Conklin Ave., across from Servepro lot, at "back in only" parking sign closest to City of Binghamton utility pole 3639.

From Conklin Ave., runners can step up on the curb for the shortest route to the S end of the South Washington Street Bridge (see photo inset on map).

Run N on South Washington Street Bridge
Turn L to follow pathway into Confluence Park.
Turn R on pathway under Memorial Bridge, heading N on River Walk. (see photo inset on map).
Stay to R on River Walk and exit onto Court St.
Turn L and run W over Court Street Bridge.
Turn L to run S on Front St.

M7: Front St., north edge of driveway to M&T.
Turn R onto Leroy St. and head W.

M8: Leroy St., at front walkway to 172 Leroy.
Turn R at West End Ave. heading N.
Turn R at Highland Ave. and head E.

M9: Highland Avenue, at W side of 23 Highland.
Turn R on Beethoven St.
Turn L on Seminary Ave.
Turn L on Laurel Ave.
Turn L on Schubert Ave.
Turn R on Schiller St.

M10: Schiller St., at driveway between 27 and 29 Schiller
Turn L on Grand Blvd. heading NW
Turn R on Britnall St.
Turn R on Main St., heading SE

M11: Main St. at E side of the corner of Crestmont Rd.

M12: Main St. at E side of the corner of Walnut.
Main St. becomes Court St. at the Court Street Bridge. Stay to the right on the Court St.
roundabout.
Turn L on Fayette St.

M13: Fayette St., at center of small parking lot SE and next to 42 Fayette

Finish: On Fayette St., north of Henry St., at the NW corner of the metal storm drain on the east side of Fayette and closest to Henry. Also 25' 10" E of storm drain on opposite side of Fayette; that storm drain is the second one from the corner of Henry and Fayette on the W side of Fayette.
